Please consult your Faculty Advisor to identify the language(s) best suited to your field of study. If you haven't established foreign language competency upon entering the graduate program, it is recommended to do so early in your graduate career. Note that language courses fulfilling this requirement do not count toward the Feminist Studies Ph.D.

The Language Requirement must be fulfilled before undertaking General Examinations.
